

Swachhata Hi Seva 2024 – Report

Date: 17th September 2024

2. Mass Scale Cleanliness Drive

Date: 19th September 2024

• Participants: 191

waste, segregating recyclables, and cleaning public spaces. The event promoted community ownership of cleanliness and further reinforced the principles of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.




3. Swachhata Hi Seva Pledge

• Date: 20th September 2024

• Participants: 260

• Description:

4.Swachhata Hi Seva Run

• Date: 21st September 2024

• Participants: 100

• Description:

A 5K run was organized to combine physical fitness with cleanliness awareness. Participants carried banners with slogans promoting cleanliness and sustainability, amplifying the campaign's message.



5. Mass Scale Cleanliness Drive (Phase 2)

• Date: 22nd September 2024

• Participants: 98

• Description:

6. Plastic-Free Campus Campaign (Public Participation Event)

• Date: 23rd September 2024

• Participants: 35

• Description:

7. Safaimitra Suraksha Shivirs – Suraksha Kits Distribution Program

• Date: 24th September 2024

• Participants: 100

Safety kits were distributed to sanitation workers, emphasizing the importance of providing them with adequate protective gear. The initiative was part of IIT Dharwad's efforts to ensure the safety and dignity of its workforce engaged in cleanliness activities.
